- The childminder has a secure understanding of her role and responsibilities in safeguarding and knows how to protect the welfare of children.
- The childminder has a clear understanding of how to support children's learning. She knows the sorts of activities that will help promote children's learning and development.
- The childminder understands the need to support children's emotional development. She is clear how she will help children learn to manage their feelings and to respect others.
- The childminder is clear how to prepare children for the next stages in their learning and their move on to pre-school or school.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

- The inspector viewed the home, resources and equipment to establish how the childminder will keep children safe and help them to learn.
