Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder has a sound awareness of requirements. She keeps her safeguarding knowledge up-to-date and is clear about procedures to follow if she had concerns about a child's welfare.
- The childminder, through discussion, has a good understanding of the importance of working in partnership with parents, professionals and other providers. She recognises the need to share information about children's progress to ensure consistency in their care and learning.
- The childminder continues to develop her skills and increase her knowledge through training opportunities. She evaluates her practice and looks for ways to improve outcomes for children.
- The childminder discussed her good understanding of the learning and development requirements. She knows how to provide a broad range of activities to challenge and motivate children so that they make good progress.
- The childminder explained how she would promote children's good health, support their physical and emotional well-being and teach them how to keep themselves safe.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children.
