Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- Since the last inspection, the childminder has improved her professional development, such as by keeping up to date with current regulations and legislation and by reading professional articles.
- The childminder and her co-childminder have a secure understanding of their roles and responsibilities in safeguarding and know how to protect the welfare of children.
- The childminder understands how to support children's learning and the need to work with parents and other early years providers that children attend to do so.
- The childminder knows the sorts of activities, inside and outside the home, that will help her promote children's learning and development.
- The childminder understands the need to support children's emotional development. She is clear how she will help children learn to manage their feelings and to respect others.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector sampled a range of documentation, including those the childminder has to record information about children.
- The inspector held discussions with the childminder about her policies and procedures, including safeguarding, making improvements to her provision, and of how she has met the recommendations made at the last inspection.
- The inspector held discussions with the childminder about how she works with her co-childminder.
- The inspector viewed the home, resources and equipment to establish how the childminder will keep children safe and help them to learn.

The childminder registered in 1991. She lives in the Elson area of Gosport. The childminder provides care Monday to Friday for most of the year. She sometimes works with her husband who is also a childminder. There were no children on roll at the time of the inspection.
