

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

On 20 October 2015 the provider notified us of a safeguarding incident, which raised concerns about the safeguarding procedures in the setting.

We liaised with other agencies. We carried out an un-announced visit to the setting to check if they were meeting the requirements of the Statutory Framework for the Early Years Foundation Stage. We found that a referral to the Local Authority Designated Officer (LADO) had not been effectively monitored and there was a lack of knowledge of specific safeguarding requirements in relation to allegations against staff.

Following our visit we issued a Notice to improve that required the provider to:

ensure that staff attend relevant training to strengthen their knowledge of safeguarding, with particular regard to the procedure for allegations and the Government's statutory guidance, 'Working Together to Safeguard Children 2013.

We carried out a further visit and found that staff had attended the appropriate training.

The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those

registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
