Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder has a clear understanding of safeguarding policies and procedures. She knows how to report any concerns and understands the importance of carrying out risk assessments and daily safety checks to help keep children safe.
- The childminder understands the importance of reviewing her practice and working in partnerships with others. For example, gathering the views of parents and others to strengthen outcomes for children.
- The childminder keeps up to date with any changes to legislation, which helps her to meet the legal requirements.
- The childminder has a clear understanding of behaviour management. She understands how to manage children's behaviour and work with parents to meet children's needs.
- The childminder is aware of how to use children's interests and next steps of learning to plan activities to promote development. She is aware of sharing these with parents and other professionals, to provide continuity of care for children.
- The childminder understands the importance of providing meals and drinks that meet children's individual dietary requirements to help promote healthy lifestyles.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector reviewed the main play areas used by children.
- The inspector spoke with the childminder to review her knowledge and understanding of the safeguarding and welfare requirements.
- The inspector reviewed documents including first aid and public liability insurance.
