## Summary of key findings for parents

### The provision meets requirements

- The childminder understands how to plan a range of experiences to meet children's needs, including activities to help children gain the necessary skills for school.
- The childminder has systems in place to recognise potential hazards and take action to minimise risks.
- The childminder knows how to support children who are learning to speak English as an additional language and children with special educational needs.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation.
