The provision meets requirements

- The childminder offers a welcoming and stimulating learning environment. She has a range of resources available to interest children and promote their learning.
- The childminder understands of how to support children to value themselves as individuals and how to help them to understand and respect others.

There were no children present when this inspection took place.
