Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder knows what to do if she has a child protection concern. She is aware of the importance of working with other professionals to safeguard children.
- The childminder has a secure understanding of how to support children's progress and provide different learning experiences. She values children's uniqueness and knows how to plan activities that reflect their interests.
- The childminder recognises the importance of providing a safe and secure learning environment for children. For example, she completes regular risk assessments.
- The childminder knows how to assess and monitor children's learning to support their next development steps.
- The childminder is aware of the need to develop positive partnerships with parents and others to support children's future learning. This helps promote continuity of care and ensures children's individual needs are met.
- The childminder reflects on the quality of her care and ensures her knowledge is up to date. For example, she undertakes personal research, attends courses and keeps abreast of relevant information.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector held discussions with the childminder to assess how she maintains her knowledge in relation to the Early Years Foundation Stage.
- The inspector observed the childminder's home and areas used for childminding.
- The inspector discussed the previous recommendation in relation to children's safety, self-evaluation, observation and assessments.
