

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

On 22 February 2016, the new provider notified Ofsted of the discovery of historical failures to report safeguarding concerns to the local authority LADO. The provider made the necessary report to LADO. The provider took immediate steps by training all practitioners on safeguarding. Practitioners now have a secure understanding of the procedures to follow and their responsibility for recording and reporting concerns. The provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Early Years Foundation Stage welfare requirements to notify Ofsted of significant events. The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.
