Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder knows how to keep children safe and provide a safe environment. She is aware of child protection issues and the correct procedures to follow if concerned.
- The childminder knows how to assess and monitor children's progress, in order to plan interesting experiences according to their learning needs.
- The childminder understands how to help children build good relationships, behave well and develop respect for others. She knows how to help children gain confidence and independence to help prepare them for starting school.
- The childminder recognises the benefits of sharing information with parents and other professionals to help her meet children's individual needs.
- The childminder is aware of the importance of evaluating what she does to help her improve her practice.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector discussed the childminder's knowledge of the Early Years Foundation Stage requirements.
- The inspector discussed with the childminder how she intends to promote children's learning and development.
- The inspector looked at a range of documents, which included policies and procedures, certificates and systems for recording information.
- The inspector looked at the space available for childminding and some of the resources the childminder will use.

The childminder registered in 2004 and lives in Eastleigh, near Southampton. She offers childcare during school holidays and for three weekdays during term time. There were no children on roll at the time of the inspection. The childminder is accredited to receive funding to provide free early years education for children aged two, three and four years. She holds a level 3 childcare qualification.
