The provision meets requirements

- The childminder has a good knowledge of how to promote children's development and move them on to their next steps learning. For example, she understands how to use observations and assessments to help her to monitor children's progress.
- The childminder understands how to support children with special educational needs and the importance of partnership working to provide continuity of care and learning.
- The childminder demonstrates a secure knowledge of safeguarding and child protection. For example, she understands how to recognise if a child may be at risk and how to report these concerns.
- The childminder has a good self-evaluation process to help identify her strengths and areas for improvement.
- The childminder has a good understanding of how to help children to form a relationship with her and knows how to use praise to build their self-esteem.
- The childminder understands the importance of helping children to develop respect for the similarities and differences of others.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children.
