The provision meets requirements

- The childminder understands the importance of teaching children healthy habits. For example, she states that she would promote the value of eating well-balanced meals and provide lots of opportunities for physical activity and fresh air.
- The childminder knows the safeguarding procedures to follow should she be concerned about a child in her care.
- The childminder understands the value of forming partnerships with parents and others involved in children's learning to support children's development.
- The childminder understands the importance of evaluating her practice to form goals for improvement to promote children's learning.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation.
