The provision meets requirements

- The childminder has a good awareness of the importance of sharing information, including children's next steps in learning, with parents and other settings.
- The childminder has a secure knowledge of the signs and symptoms that could cause a concern regarding a child's welfare. She has a good understanding of the procedures to follow to raise a concern.
- The childminder has a good understanding of the Early Years Foundation Stage and how to support children's learning. She knows how to monitor and identify any gaps in children's development.
- The childminder has a good understanding of how to promote children's emotional and physical well-being. She knows the importance of teaching children to be healthy through daily exercise and a nutritious and healthy diet.
- The childminder knows how to prepare children for the next stages in their learning and their move to school or nursery. She understands the importance of promoting their independence and personal care skills, to help them develop the skills they will need for their future learning.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children.
