

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

On 14 March 2016, the provider notified us of an incident. This meant that the provider met their legal responsibility to notify Ofsted of any significant incidents within 14 days. We needed to check to make sure that the provider was meeting the early years foundation stage safeguarding and welfare requirements relating to risk assessment, outings and staff suitability.

We contacted the provider to discuss the issue. We found that the setting had failed to collect a child from school on one occasion. The child remained in the care of the school until the setting returned to collect the child. This was within a few minutes. This was put down to an error in communicating correct information to staff that were collecting children.

The provider took appropriate action following the incident to review their risk assessment in order to reduce any risk of further incidents occurring. The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
