Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder understands how to monitor children's progress to help them reach their next steps in learning, especially those who are learning to speak English as an additional language.
- The childminder uses her established links with other childminders and accesses training regularly to keep up to date with current changes to legislation, and to refresh her understanding of teaching and learning.
- The childminder is knowledgeable about following child protection procedures. She is aware of who to contact should she have any concerns about a child's welfare.
- The childminder understands the importance of supporting children to develop healthy lifestyles, including the provision of daily outdoor play.
- The childminder knows how to work with parents to meet their children's needs. She knows how to seek parents' feedback and use it to improve her practice further.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector talked with the childminder about how she intends to deliver the safeguarding and welfare requirements, and the learning and development requirements.
- The inspector viewed the areas of the home intended for the use of childminding.
- The inspector looked at a range of documentation, including registration documents, suitability checks, record of risk assessments and the childminder's training certificates.
