Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder offers a welcoming environment. She knows how to provide a suitable range of resources for children of different ages and abilities.
- The childminder understands how to monitor children's development and help them progress to their next stage in learning.
- The childminder recognises the importance of working in partnership with parents to help provide a consistent approach. She knows the need to provide parents with regular feedback about children's progress and to help support their learning at home.
- The childminder knows how to offer an inclusive service to help children learn to accept and value each other's differences.
- The childminder is aware of how to prepare children for their move to school or nursery. She knows the importance of promoting their independence and personal care skills.
- The childminder understands the procedures to follow should she have any safeguarding concerns. She recognises the signs and symptoms that would cause her to be concerned about a child's welfare.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector held discussions with the childminder about her knowledge and understanding of the Early Years Foundation Stage requirements.
- The inspector viewed the areas of the premises available for childminding.
- The inspector viewed a sample of documentation, including the childminder's first-aid certificate and suitability checks.
