Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder is fully aware of her responsibilities to deliver the learning and development requirements to help children make progress towards the early learning goals.
- The childminder has a secure knowledge and understanding of the safeguarding and welfare requirements. She is fully aware of child protection procedures to safeguard children and keeps up to date about changes in legislation.
- The childminder demonstrates commitment to working in partnership with parents and other people involved in the children's development, to meet their individual needs.
- The childminder has a positive attitude towards the continual development of her service to benefit children and their families.
- The childminder recognises the importance of promoting healthy lifestyles, such as through providing nutritional food, and regular exercise. She is aware of how to manage children's behaviour to promote their well-being.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
