

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

On 29 March 2016, we received a notification from the provider about an allegation. This means that the provider met their legal responsibilities in informing Ofsted of allegations. We needed to check to make sure that the Early Years Foundation Stage safeguarding and welfare requirements were being met. In particular, the requirements relating to safeguarding practice.

We carried out an unannounced visit. We found that the setting had received two allegations. We found that contact had not been made in a timely manner on both occasions with the relevant outside agencies.

As a result, we issued the provider with a notice to improve that asks them to:

- ensure timely contact is made with outside agencies in the event of an allegation being made against any member of staff.

The provider responded appropriately to the action raised and remains registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website

for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
