- The childminder has a sound understanding of how to safeguard children and she regularly updates her training. This helps keep her knowledge of her role and responsibility in reporting any child protection concerns current. Additionally, the childminder knows how to keep her home safe and secure for children.
- The childminder demonstrates is aware of the need to evaluate and develop her practice in order to improve outcomes for children.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children.
