### Summary of key findings for parents

#### The provision meets requirements

- The childminder understands how to promote children's learning and development. She knows how to observe and assess children's progress and plan for the next steps in their learning.
- The childminder knows how to safeguard children. She has completed relevant training and knows the procedures to follow if she has a concern about a child.
- The childminder understands how to manage children's behaviour and teach them to respect each other.
- The childminder has kept up-to-date with training. She understands how to evaluate her practice to promote continuous improvement.
- The childminder understands how to promote children's health and well-being, including providing children with regular experiences outdoors, daily exercise, and a healthy diet.
- The childminder understands the importance of developing partnerships with parents to help her meet the individual needs of children.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

- The inspector viewed all areas of the home that are used for childminding purposes.
- The inspector talked to the childminder about her understanding of the requirements for safeguarding and welfare, and learning and development.
