- The childminder understands her roles and responsibilities in keeping children safe. She maintains a secure environment and knows what action she would take if she had any welfare concerns.
- The childminder knows how to work in partnership with parents and other settings that children attend, to share information about children's progress.
- The childminder knows how to use her observations and assessment of children's learning to monitor their progress.
- The childminder knows how to support children's emotional and physical well-being. For example, she provides healthy foods and daily opportunities for exercise.
- The childminder understands how to keep her skills and knowledge up to date and the value of training in improving her practice further.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation.
