Summary of key findings for parents

The provision does not meet requirements

- The childminder has not provided Ofsted with information that enables them to complete suitability checks for people aged 16 years or over living on the premises. The adult holds a Disclosure and Barring Service check.
- The childminder has a good understanding of how children learn. She has systems in place to observe children and plan challenging activities based on their next steps. The childminder understands the importance of sharing information with parents, other providers and agencies to support children's learning and how to offer an inclusive service.
- The childminder has a range of strategies to promote children's positive behaviour and raise their self-confidence and self-esteem. She explains how she would support children's emotional well-being and how she would form positive attachments with children.
- The childminder displays a good understanding of how to identify concerns relating to children's welfare and how to report them to the relevant agencies. She maintains a range of documentation to help her to keep children safe.
- The childminder attends training to enhance her skills and knowledge based on her own identified training needs. Training has had a positive impact on the childminders knowledge. She understands the skills children need to acquire for their move to school and has strategies in place to ensure children are supported emotionally.
- The childminder's home is welcoming. She provides a range of toys and equipment which are organised to enable children to be self-motivated and independent in their play.
- The childminder explains how she would support children's healthy lifestyles and promote their physical well-being. She has a range of policies and procedures in place to support children's good health, such as healthy eating and hygiene routines.
- The childminder understands the skills children need to acquire for their move to school and has strategies in place to ensure children are supported emotionally.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

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What the setting needs to do to improve further
