- The childminder understands the importance of promoting children's physical health and well-being, such as through healthy eating and developing their independence skills.
- The childminder recognises the importance of working in partnership with parents and other agencies to share information and promote continuity.
- The childminder understands how to complete risk assessments to ensure her premises are welcoming and safe for children. She knows how to manage children's behaviour and the importance of teaching children to respect others.
- The childminder knows how to evaluate her practice and use the views of parents and children to help her decide on priorities for improvement, to improve practice.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation.
