There were no children present when this inspection took place. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Manor Kids Club registered in 2001. The club operates from Manor Infant School, in Farnborough, Hampshire. It is open five days a week, from 3.10pm to 5.30pm, during school term time only. There are six staff, five of whom hold qualifications. There were no children present at the time of this inspection.
