- The childminder understands the importance of helping children to respect one another and to teach them how to behave well. She recognises how to provide activities that help children make progress and gain the skills needed for school.
- The childminder is aware of the need to evaluate her practice to promote continuous improvement.
- The childminder understands the benefits of working with parents to provide children with continuity in their learning and promote children's emotional well-being.
- The childminder understands how to promote children's physical well-being and provide them with daily opportunities for outdoor play and exercise.
- The childminder understands safeguarding procedures to protect children's welfare. She is aware of what to look out for and her responsibility to report any child protection concerns to the relevant agency.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children.
