

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

On 15 February 2016 we received information from an outside agency with concerns that the setting were not following Local Safeguarding Children's Board (LSCB) policy on reporting injuries to children, including injuries that children were arriving at the setting with.

On 2 March 2016 we also received information from a third party detailing a range of concerns relating to: the quality of education delivered to children at the setting, insufficient space, injuries to children being reported to the local authority unnecessarily, toileting routines for children.

We carried out an announced visit to the setting to investigate these concerns.

As a result of our visit we established that all aspects of the concerns raised on 2 March were unfounded.

Regarding the concerns raised on 15 February we found that the setting had failed to follow LSCB policy, and therefore their own policy, around reporting child injuries to the relevant team in the local authority. Due to this we issued the provider with a notice of action to improve that required them to;

Ensure that the setting's own policy, and that of the Local Safeguarding Children Board, is followed related to the reporting of injuries to children.

We were satisfied with the provider's response to the action set.

The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
