Summary of key findings for parents

The provision does not meet requirements

- The childminder does not have enough understanding of the learning and development requirements. She is not familiar enough with the seven areas of learning. She is unclear about how to use observations to assess children's development and plan for their next steps in learning.
- The childminder does not undertake effective self-evaluation and improvement planning to make sure she meets all requirements.
- The parts of the premises to be used for childcare purposes are very welcoming. The childminder has a suitable range of resources to support children's independent play.
- The childminder understands how to keep children safe. She knows how to undertake risk assessments to identify and minimise hazards in the home and on outings. She has a current first-aid certificate and public liability insurance.
- The childminder has a suitable understanding of how to work in partnership with parents and identify children's individual care needs. She understands how to help children to settle into her setting and how to manage their behaviour positively. She has suitable plans in place to promote healthy eating and provide daily outdoor play.
- The childminder attends regular safeguarding training and she has a very secure understanding of child protection procedures. She knows she must report any concerns she may have about the welfare of children.
- The childminder understands the requirement to notify Ofsted of any changes and to keep a daily record of children's attendance.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

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What the setting needs to do to improve further

To meet the requirements of the Early Years Foundation Stage the provider must:
