The provision meets requirements

- The childminder confidently describes appropriate safeguarding procedures. She is aware of her responsibilities to keep children safe in her home and on outings, for example, when going to the local duck pond or farm. She has good procedures to ensure any accidents are recorded and shared with parents.
- The childminder understands the importance of working in partnerships with parents and has good methods to achieve this. She knows how to support children to feel safe and secure in her care, for example, by offering settling-in sessions.
- The childminder has good arrangements to monitor children's progress. She confidently identifies suitable and interesting activities to support their learning and development and prepare them for their eventual move to school.
- The childminder understands how to promote children's independence and selfconfidence to help them to become happy and motivated learners, and to promote their social skills.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation.
