Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder understands how to promote children's development and move them on to their next steps learning. She understands how to plan interesting and challenging activities to help children to make good progress.
- The childminder understands how to support children with English as an additional language and the importance of working with parents to support children's learning.
- The childminder has a secure knowledge of safeguarding and child protection. She knows how to identify if a child may be at risk and how to report these concerns.
- The childminder understands the importance of self-evaluation to help identify her strengths and areas for improvement, and include the views and suggestions of staff and parents.
- The childminder understands the importance of building a secure relationship with children to promote their well-being and knows how to use praise to build their self-esteem. The childminder understands the importance of helping children to develop respect for similarities and differences in others.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The childminder registered in 2014. The childminder works from the home of another registered childminder under the name 'Little Wombles' in the London Borough of Wandsworth. The childminder is open from 8am to 6pm, Monday to Friday, for 48 weeks a year. At the time of the inspection there were no children on roll.
