Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder knows how to plan activities and learning experiences to meet children's needs. She is aware of how to monitor their learning and understands how to support children's ongoing development to help them make progress.
- The childminder understands her responsibilities to keep children safe. She is aware of safeguarding procedures and knows how to recognise the signs that may indicate a cause for concern.
- The childminder understands the importance of working in partnership with parents. She recognises the importance of sharing information with other early years providers to support a consistent approach to meeting children's needs.
- The childminder has a safe and secure home. She knows how to promote children's well-being and support their good health.
- The childminder knows how to support children's good behaviour and emotional well-being.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector discussed with the childminder how she intends to support children's play and learning.
- The inspector viewed the areas of the childminder's house, which are used for the care of children, and looked at the range of toys and resources available.
- The inspector reviewed documentation, including policies and evidence of suitability for the childminder and household members.

The childminder registered in 1992. She lives in the city of Wells in Somerset. She offers care from Monday to Friday, all year round, except for Christmas and bank holidays. There were no children on roll in the early years age range when this inspection took place.
