Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder has an understanding of how children learn and develop. She knows how to plan for, assess and support children's ongoing progress.
- The childminders home is clean, well maintained and child friendly. She has a sufficient amount of toys and resources to help her promote children's learning in all areas.
- The childminder understands how to manage children's behaviour and encourage them to behave positively.
- The childminder ensures she keeps her knowledge up-to-date and has recently attended safeguarding training. She is confident in the signs, symptoms and referral processes for child protection to help keep children safe.
- The childminder comprehends the importance of working in partnerships with parents to provide continuity in children's care, education and well-being.
- The childminder recognises how to evaluate her practice to drive improvements.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
