Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder understands her responsibilities and the importance of safeguarding children. She is aware of the procedures she must follow in the event of a concern about a child in her care.
- The childminder recognises the importance of working in partnership with parents and other providers or agencies to ensure a consistent approach to children's care and learning.
- The childminder understands the importance of helping children to learn skills that prepare them for starting pre-school and school. She describes how she will support children in becoming independent and confident individuals.
- The childminder describes how she will use the local area to help children learn about the world around them and differences in people in society.
- The childminder has increased her understanding of how to reflect on her practice. She understands the importance of identifying her strengths and areas to develop, in order to improve outcomes for parents and their children.
- The childminder demonstrates that she understands her responsibilities with regard to administering medication to children. This includes keeping records and ensuring that parents are informed when this is carried out.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector spoke with the childminder throughout the inspection.
- The inspector viewed the areas of the childminder's home that are used for childminding.
- The inspector discussed with the childminder how she plans to meet the requirements of the early years foundation stage and promote children's progress.
- The inspector checked a range of documentation, including the suitability checks of adults living on the premises, training certificates and policies.

The childminder was registered in 2013 and lives in Coventry. She operates all year round from 7am to 6.30pm, Monday to Friday, except bank holidays and family holidays.
