

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

On 14 July 2016 Ofsted received concerns regarding the nurseries compliance with the following requirements of the Statutory Framework for the Early Years Foundation Stage: W5.2 Child supervision, W7 Managing Behaviour, W5.3 Staff deployment, W10.3 Information for parents and carers and W10.4 Complaints. As a result, an Early Years Regulatory Inspector visited the nursery. During the visit the inspector found that staff deployment when children were playing outdoors was an area of weakness. This had resulted in an increased number of incidents in the outdoor area. This is a breach to the requirement W5.3 Staff deployment. As a result, a Notice to Improve was issued asking the provider to ensure that staff are well deployed when supervising children's outdoor play to reduce the number of accidents and/or incidents in the outdoor area. The nursery wrote to Ofsted to tell us that they had strengthened arrangements for supervising children's outdoor play. Compliance with this action will be checked at the next inspection. At this time the nursery remains registered with Ofsted.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
