Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The provider understands her responsibilities to make the environment safe and secure for children. They know how to encourage children to follow the rules and to promote their positive behaviour.
- The provider has a sound knowledge of how to keep children safe, including what she would do if she had a concern about a child to protect their welfare.
- The provider has a strong commitment to continually improve the setting. They have devised effective procedures to obtain the views of staff, parents and children to identify priorities for improvement.
- The provider has effective systems to support staff's professional development. For example, staff benefit from regular frequent training opportunities to enhance their knowledge and the care they provide.
- Staff know how to provide a variety of play activities to support children's interests. They understand the importance of working in partnership with parents and other professionals to provide consistency for children's care.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

- The inspector viewed the areas used by the children at the holiday club.
- The inspector sampled the clubs documentation, including various records.
- The inspector discussed the provider's understanding of the requirements of the Early Years Foundation Stage.

Shout! Holiday Activities registered in 2004. It is managed by Elmbridge Borough Council and based in Walton-on-Thames, Surrey. The group is open on weekdays during most school holidays from 8.30am to 5.30pm. At the time of this inspection, there were no children on roll in the early years age group.
