Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder has an up-to-date understanding of safeguarding and protecting children from harm. She understands her responsibilities towards child protection, including the indicators that cause concern and how to report these to the appropriate agencies.
- The childminder knows how to monitor her work and seeks ways to improve her skills and knowledge, such as through training, to keep her up to date with changes in childcare practice and legislation.
- The childminder understands how to use resources and activities to challenge children and help them make progress in their learning. She knows how to identify children's starting points and observe their individual development.
- The childminder recognises the need to work in partnership with parents, including the importance of sharing information regularly to meet their children's care and learning needs.
- The childminder maintains her paediatric first-aid qualification. She is aware of how this helps her to respond to children's minor accidents and emergencies.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
