- Staff know how to help children to make healthy choices and be active, to promote their healthy lifestyles and physical well-being.
- The manager recognises the importance of evaluating the setting. She understands her role in monitoring and developing staff's skills to improve the club's overall quality.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Abelle Kids Club William Ford and Village Infants registered in 2014 and is managed by a limited company. The setting operates from the premises of William Ford Church of England School in Dagenham, within the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham. The setting provides out-of-school care for children attending William Ford Church of England School and Village Infants School only. Sessions operate Monday to Friday term-time from 7.30am to 9am and 3.10pm to 6pm. The setting employs six members of staff, this includes the manager. Of these, three staff hold appropriate early years qualifications. There were no children in the early years age group present at the time of the inspection.
