Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- Leaders and staff have a secure knowledge of safeguarding issues. They understand the signs when a child may be at risk of harm and know the procedures to follow if they have a concern about a child's welfare.
- Leaders are aware of the need to reflect on their practice and understand the importance of taking into account the views of parents and children. They have addressed the areas of development identified at the last inspection successfully. For example, all staff now hold first aid qualifications.
- Leaders know how to plan activities and offer a variety of resources for children's play. They understand the importance of working in partnership with the host school and parents to complement children's experiences and interests outside of the club.
- Leaders and staff are aware of how to help children understand behavioural expectations. They know how to support children's independence and individual choices.
- Leaders and staff understand the importance of supporting children's good health and will provide children with opportunities to play outside and be physically active.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

- The inspector viewed the areas of the premises used for childcare.

Mighty Oaks @ Ashton Keynes registered in 2011. It operates from a classroom and school hall of Ashton Keynes Primary School. Children have access to the school playground and enclosed playing field. The club is open each weekday during term time between 3.15pm and 6pm, and all day during the school holidays. The club employs two members of staff, both of whom hold a relevant childcare qualification at level 3. At the time of this inspection there were no children in the early years age group present.
