Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The manager and staff know how to support children in learning about staying safe. For example, they plan visits with the local community police officer to talk about safety, including how to use the internet safely.
- The manager and staff know how to provide a range of different activities and play opportunities to keep children interested and occupied. There is a good range of toys and equipment to suit children's individual needs and backgrounds.
- The manager and staff know how to safeguard children. They know what to do if they are concerned about a child's welfare.
- The manager implements methods for monitoring the provision. She has acted on recommendations since the last inspection, such as giving children more opportunity to be independent.
- The manager and staff know how to enable children to learn the boundaries and expectations to behave appropriately. They learn to respect and value others.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector spoke to the manager and staff about their practice and procedures, and how they intend to provide children with suitable activities.
- The inspector viewed the areas of the premises that will be used and discussed safety arrangements.
- The inspector looked at samples of documentation, including staff records and records used to support children's welfare.
- The inspector discussed with the manager the systems for self-evaluation.

Charlton Triangle Kids Club Ltd re-registered with Ofsted in 2012 following a move to different premises, having been established since 2004. The club provides an out-of-school service in the Charlton Village area of the London Borough of Greenwich. It operates from the Mascalls Meeting Room which is a purpose-built community building. The club operates each weekday during term time providing a breakfast club from 7.30am and staff escort children to school. After school, children are collected and walk back to the club with staff where they can remain until 6pm. The club also operates during various school holidays from 8am to 6pm. The club offers care to children who are aged four years and in school Reception classes, and for children up to 11 years old. There is a core team of seven staff including the manager, and at least three staff work with the children each day. Staff hold recognised early years qualifications.

This inspection was carried out by Ofsted under sections 49 and 50 of the Childcare Act 2006 on the quality and standards of provision that is registered on the Early Years Register. The registered person must ensure that this provision complies with the statutory framework for children's learning, development and care, known as the early years foundation stage.
