Summary of key findings for parents

The provision does not meet requirements

- Children's safety is compromised. The childminder is not fully aware of the safeguarding procedures to follow if she has concerns that a child may be at risk of harm.
- The childminder does not fully maintain a daily record of the names of children looked after on the premises, including their hours of attendance.
- Information gained from parents when children first start is based on individual care needs. The childminder does not gain enough detail about what children already know and can do.
- Strategies for engaging with parents and other professionals about children's learning and development are weak.
- The childminder does not record the name, home address and date of birth of children on both parts of the Childcare Register. Further still, she does not record parental details for each child who is looked after on the premises.
- The childminder has an appropriate understanding of how to promote children's well-being. She is aware of the importance of providing them with a healthy diet and ensuring they have regular opportunities to be active outside.
- The childminder has a suitable understanding of how children learn and develop. She explains how she uses observations and assessments to plan precisely for children's future learning.
- The childminder holds a current first-aid qualification and public liability insurance.
- The childminder has addressed previous actions and recommendations. She demonstrates a commitment to driving improvement and evaluating her service.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

What the setting needs to do to improve further

To meet the requirements of the early years foundation stage and the Childcare Register the provider must:
