## Summary of key findings for parents

### The provision meets requirements

- The childminder understands safeguarding procedures and has attended relevant training to keep her knowledge up to date. She knows what to do and who to contact if she has concerns about a child's welfare.
- The childminder knows how to provide a safe environment and how to reduce risks to help prevent accidents.
- The childminder understands the importance of teaching children about healthy lifestyles to support their well-being.
- The childminder knows how to manage behaviour and how to encourage tolerance and respect for people from different backgrounds.
- The childminder understands how to support children's development. She knows how to provide a range of activities to encourage children to acquire new skills and build on previous learning.
- The childminder understands the importance of working in partnership with parents and other people involved in children's care.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
