## The quality and standards of the early years provision

## Summary of key findings for parents

### The provision meets requirements

- The management team demonstrates knowledge and understanding of the requirements and how these relate to holiday provision. The management team explains how parents will be kept informed about their children's time at the club through daily feedback.
- The management team gave examples of the kinds of resources and activities that will be on offer during the holiday club. Managers show a secure understanding of how these will support children's ongoing learning and development through play.
- The management team demonstrates an understanding of how to ensure children are safe while at the club. Risk assessments are in place. Managers are aware of their responsibilities to protect children from abuse and neglect. They are clear about what to do when concerns arise about a child's welfare.
- The management team understands how to support children in maintaining a healthy lifestyle. A policy is in place to guide practice when lunches are brought into the club from home. Plans are in place for children to take part in a wide range of sporting activities.
- The management team explains how they intend to make use of staff meetings, induction procedures and ongoing monitoring to ensure the quality of the provision. Managers demonstrate how they plan to seek the views of parents and children about the provision.
- The management team understands the importance of encouraging children to be independent throughout their play and daily routines. They explain how they plan to support children to develop confidence and self-care skills. Plans are in place to allocate a key person to each child, in order to help promote their emotional well-being.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

## Inspection activities

- The inspector had in-depth discussions with the childcare services managers and early years development lead, relating to their knowledge and understanding of the requirements for safeguarding and welfare, and learning and development.
- The inspector looked at documents the club plans to use when caring for children, including registration forms, policies and risk assessments.
- The inspector viewed the areas of the sports centre that would be used by the holiday club and talked with the management team about how it would ensure the safety of children.
- The inspector spoke with the management team about the range of resources and activities that would be on offer when the club was running.
- The inspector checked evidence of the suitability of the management team. She discussed with them the process for recruiting and inducting new staff.

Schools Out Ramsey was registered in 2014 and is owned by Davison-Roberts Ltd. There are three members of the management team, all of whom hold appropriate early years qualifications at level 3. The club opens from Monday to Friday during school holidays only. Sessions are from 8am until 6pm. The provider operates a number of other nurseries and wraparound care settings.

This inspection was carried out by Ofsted under sections 49 and 50 of the Childcare Act 2006 on the quality and standards of provision that is registered on the Early Years Register. The registered person must ensure that this provision complies with the statutory framework for children's learning, development and care, known as the early years foundation stage.

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
