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Summary of key findings for parents

The provision does not meet requirements

- The childminder does not meet the Early Years Register and Childcare register requirements. She has failed to obtain required suitability checks for all adults living on the premises, and to inform Ofsted as required. She does not hold a current paediatric first-aid qualification and has failed to renew public liability insurance.
- The childminder does not maintain daily records of children's names and hours of attendance. Not all required documentation is available for inspection, including a written statement for safeguarding and complaints. The childminder knows how to report a concern about a child's welfare and keeps her premises safe. However, she does not know all the signs that a child may be at risk of harm.
- The childminder does not have sufficient knowledge and understanding of the learning and development requirements and how to identify children's next steps in learning. She is not aware of her responsibility to complete a progress check for children aged between two and three years, and to share this with parents.
- The childminder does not evaluate her practice and does not keep her knowledge up to date. The action from the previous inspection in relation to first-aid has not been met.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

What the setting needs to do to improve further

To meet the requirements of the early years foundation stage and the Childcare Register the provider must:

The childminder registered in 1998. She lives in Tooting, in the London Borough of Wandsworth. The childminder operates from Monday to Friday from 8am to 6pm, all year round, except for family and bank holidays. There were no children on roll at the time of the inspection.
