

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

On Tuesday 16 September 2016, the provider notified Ofsted of a significant event regarding the security of the setting. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Early Years Foundation Stage welfare requirements to inform Ofsted of any significant event which is likely to affect the suitability of the early years provider or any person who cares for, or is in regular contact with, children on the premises to look after children.

We looked into this concern to see whether the nursery was meeting the Statutory Framework for the Early Years Foundation Stage requirements. We paid particular attention to the requirements relating to the security of the premises, risk assessment, ratios and staff deployment.

The provider wrote to us and provided information about the action they had taken to improve the safety arrangements. We carried out an unannounced visit to the nursery. We viewed documents, held discussions with managers and staff and observed practice. At the visit found that the provider had taken action to improve risk assessments, security of premises and staff deployment.

The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
