Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The well-qualified childminder understands how to meet the learning and development requirements. She has experience of observing, assessing and planning activities to help children make progress in their learning.
- The childminder has a clear understanding of the safeguarding and welfare requirements. She is able to explain child protection procedures and what she would do if she was worried about a child.
- The childminder knows how to minimise risks in the home and on outings to help keep children safe.
- The childminder understands how to teach children rules, boundaries and positive behaviour.
- The childminder understands how to work effectively with parents and to share information with other providers who also care and educate the children.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

- The inspector viewed the premises and play resources with the childminder.
- The inspector looked at documents provided by the childminder.
- The inspector discussed the childminder's understanding of how to meet children's learning and care needs.
