

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

On 7 September 2016, the provider notified us that there had been an unexplained injury to a child at the setting. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Early Years Foundation Stage requirements to notify Ofsted of a significant event. On 7 September 2016, we telephoned the provider to discuss the notification. On 12 September 2016, we received a copy of the provider's investigation into the incident. On 1 November 2016, we visited the setting to see whether the provider was meeting the requirements of the Early Years Foundation Stage; in particular the requirements relating to safeguarding practice, safeguarding policy and accidents or injuries. We found that the provider had completed an investigation. As a result, they had taken action to improve their reporting and recording systems for incidents which occur outside the provision and provided staff with additional safeguarding training, which included ensuring all staff are aware of how to contact the designated safeguarding lead when they have concerns about a child's welfare.

We are satisfied with the action the provider has taken. The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website

for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
