Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The manager and staff understand the welfare requirements to keep children safe. The manager has attended training to help her and staff understand how to protect children from harm, including extreme behaviours and views.
- Staff know how to provide a wide range of activities that help children engage after a busy day at school. Staff are able to share how they can support children to be confident and play together harmoniously.
- Staff are aware of how to develop good relationships with children. They recognise the benefits of working with parents to find out about children's individual interests and family backgrounds, to help them settle children into the club.
- The manager understands how to use self-evaluation to make changes. This has led her to provide a new display board for parents and children to contribute their own ideas and suggestions.
- The manager is able to share how working closely with teaching staff from the local school helps them to support children's well-being and learning experiences.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

- The inspector held an interview with the manager.
- The inspector observed staff and older children's interactions.
- The inspector spoke to parents and older children about their views of the provision.
- The inspector looked at a range of documentation, such as staff suitability.

Twiglets registered in 2000 and is located within Topsham School, Devon. The club is open Monday to Friday between 3.30pm and 5.30pm, term time only. There are five members of staff, all of whom hold relevant qualifications from levels 2 to 4. There were no early years children present at the time of the inspection.
