

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

On 6 December 2016 we received information that raised concerns about the provider's ability to; maintain ratios, supervise children, deploy staff and maintain risk assessments and the safety of premises. At an inspection we looked at the concerns to see whether the provider was meeting the early years foundation stage requirements relating to: risk assessment: in particular that the provider must ensure they take all reasonable steps to ensure children are not exposed to risks and identify aspects of the environment that pose a risk; premises: to ensure children cannot leave the premises unsupervised and that no unauthorised persons can enter; supervision: to ensure children are adequately supervised and deploy staff to ensure their needs are met; safety: to ensure premises are fit for purpose and comply with health and safety regulations. We found that the out-of-school club premises were not secure. Risks to children have not been adequately considered to ensure children cannot leave the premises unsupervised and that no unauthorised persons can enter. Following our inspection, we sent the provider a notice to improve that asked them to: ensure risk assessments are in place that maintain children's safety in relation to the out of school club door so that children cannot leave the premises unsupervised and that no unauthorised persons can enter. The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
