Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder's home is free from hazards. She knows how to minimise hazards and organise the space and resources for childcare purposes.
- The childminder knows how to reduce the spread of germs to children. She understands the importance of healthy foods and exercise to support children's health.
- The childminder understands child protection issues and knows what action to take if she was to have concerns about a child's welfare.
- The childminder recognises the importance of forming partnerships with parents and other carers to encourage a consistent approach to their children's care and learning.
- The childminder understands how to manage children's behaviour and teaches them to respect others. She knows how to carry out assessments and plan activities to help children progress in all areas of learning.
- The childminder updates her professional knowledge, for example, she has completed a number of training courses. She consults with the early years advisors for guidance and is aware of how to evaluate her practice to make improvements.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector had discussions with the childminder about her role and responsibilities.
- The inspector completed a tour of the areas of the childminder's home used for childminding, and viewed the toys and resources available.
- The inspector sampled a range of documentation, which includes training certificates, policies, and the public liability insurance certificate.

The childminder registered in 2013. She lives in Leytonstone, in the London Borough of Waltham Forest. The childminder operates all year round. At the time of the inspection, there were no children on roll.
