Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder is aware of her roles and responsibilities to protect children. She keeps her knowledge of safeguarding and the procedures to follow if she had a concern about the welfare of a child in her care updated.
- The childminder understands how to support and monitor children's learning and progress. She is aware of how to help prepare for the next stages in their learning, including starting school.
- The childminder discusses how she attends a range of training courses to help her extend her practice. She is aware of the need to evaluate and reflect on her strengths and weaknesses to help her to improve further.
- The childminder understands the importance of providing healthy food and regular opportunities to exercise in the fresh air.
- The childminder understands the importance of working with parents and other professionals to help support children and meet their individual needs.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector observed whole of the ground floor, which is used for childminding.
- The inspector spoke to the childminder about her knowledge of the early years requirements, including safeguarding, and learning and development.
- The inspector reviewed some of the childminder's documentation.
