## Summary of key findings for parents

### The provision meets requirements

- The childminder has a suitable understanding of how children learn and develop. She knows how to use assessments to help plan activities to support children's learning.
- The childminder understands the importance of using praise and encouragement to enhance children's personal, social and emotional development, and how to manage children's behaviour.
- The childminder has a suitable knowledge of safeguarding matters, including how to report any concerns about children's welfare.
- The childminder is aware of the value of working in partnerships with parents and others involved in children's care to promote continuity of care and learning.
- The childminder has successfully addressed the recommendations made at her last inspection. She understands the importance of keeping her training and knowledge up to date, and shows a commitment to ongoing improvement.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
